JAMES TREVELIAN, of Hanover County

DEED dated 9 January 1804

Consideration: Five Hundred Dollars current money

Conveyance:

"One water grist mill standing in the County of Louisa
aforesaid on the South Anna river, a little below the mouth
of (blank) creek & Mulford or Munfords bridge, commonly known
and called by the name of Bernard's mill, with all apparatus,
privileges, advantages & immunities thereunto belonging or
thereto in any manner pertaining; as also ten acres of land
to be the same, more or less, with its appurtenances attached
to the said mill & lying on both sides of the river, including
two islands, which said ten acres of land is bounded by the
lines of Shirley Tisdale & Joseph Bickley."
