Amount of income from interest or profits which have been received within the year next preceding the 1st of February, arising from companies or corporations, and which have been paid to the shareholders or partners of such companies or corporations, shall pay taxes thereon into the treasury, taxed at 3 per cent. Amount of income from interest or profits, which are received within the year next preceding the 1st of February, by individuals, shall be declared by banks and companies incorporated under the laws of this State, and by every person, firm or partnership, engaged in any trade or business, to the Commissioner of the Revenue, on the 1st of February, and shall pay taxes thereon into the treasury, taxed at 3 per cent. Amount of income from interest or profits, which are received within the year next preceding the 1st of February, by individuals, shall be declared by banks and companies incorporated under the laws of this State, and by every person, firm or partnership, engaged in any trade or business, to the Commissioner of the Revenue, on the 1st of February, and shall pay taxes thereon into the treasury, taxed at 3 per cent. The net income or profits, exceeding five hundred dollars, and not exceeding one thousand dollars, received by an individual, shall be taxed at 1 per cent. on every \$100 value thereof. The net income or profits, exceeding five hundred dollars, and not exceeding one thousand dollars, received by a partnership, shall be taxed at 1 per cent. on every \$100 value thereof. The net income or profits, exceeding five hundred dollars, and not exceeding one thousand dollars, received by a firm or partnership, shall be taxed at 1 per cent. on every \$100 value thereof. Fees of office, accruing within the year ending on the 1st of February, exceeding five hundred dollars, shall be taxed at 1 per cent. on every \$100 value thereof.
